UCDA Submits its Comments on Drive Clean!

The UCDA has shared its thoughts with the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change on the Ministry's Proposal to eliminate Drive Clean testing on the sale of light duty vehicles.

While the Proposal does not go as far as eliminating Drive Clean entirely it would eliminate the need for members to test vehicles prior to selling them, regardless of the vehicle's age.
